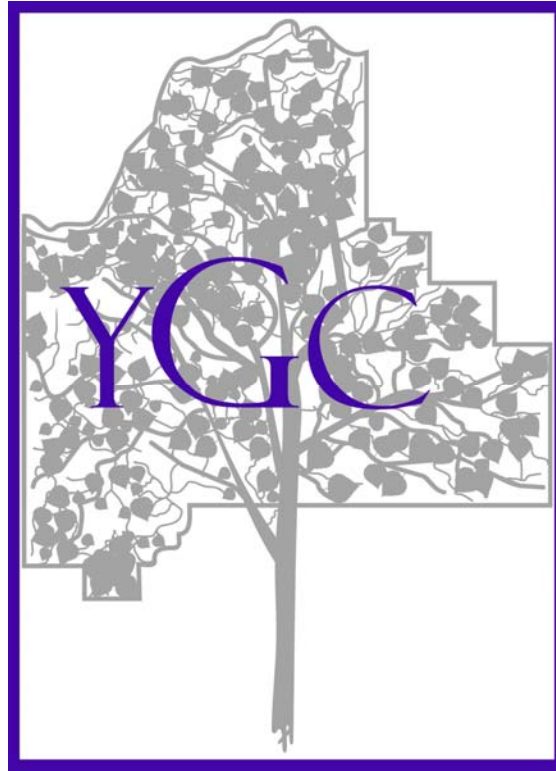

Mission Statement

The Mission of the Scott County Youth Grant Making Council is to improve the lives of the children of Scott County by:

1. Providing the Youth of Scott County a voice through philanthropy,
2. Appropriating funding to programs directly affecting the youth of Scott County through grants,
3. Educating the public about the Youth Grant Making Council, its mission, and its activities both past and present,
4. Encouraging the general public to donate resources for the fulfillment of the Youth Grant Making Council's mission.

Areas of Interest

Programs that the Scott County Youth Grantmaking Council will look favorably on include:

1. Community Service - to support programs related to community development, citizen involvement, leadership training, recreation, and general community programs and projects.
2. Social Service - to support human service organizations, programs for children, youth, family, and senior citizens.
3. Education - to support programs, projects, and scholarship in pre-school, secondary, post-secondary, and special education areas.
4. Health - to support hospital, health, and medical related programs, positive development of youth.

However, consideration of grant requests will not be limited to these four areas.

Keep in Mind...

- Your project must, in some way, benefit the youth of Scott County.
- Applicants may be called to appear for an interview with the council prior to acceptance of their grant application.
- Applicants awarded grants will be required to appear for evaluation after the project has been completed.
- Your project must have at least one adult coordinator.
- The maximum amount of money available per request is \$1,000.
- Each organization may make only one grant request per year.

Feel free to elaborate on any of your answers to the questions above or to include any extra information about your project you feel is important and the Youth Grantmaking Council should know. Please remember that all projects need to emphasize the youth and children of Scott County.
